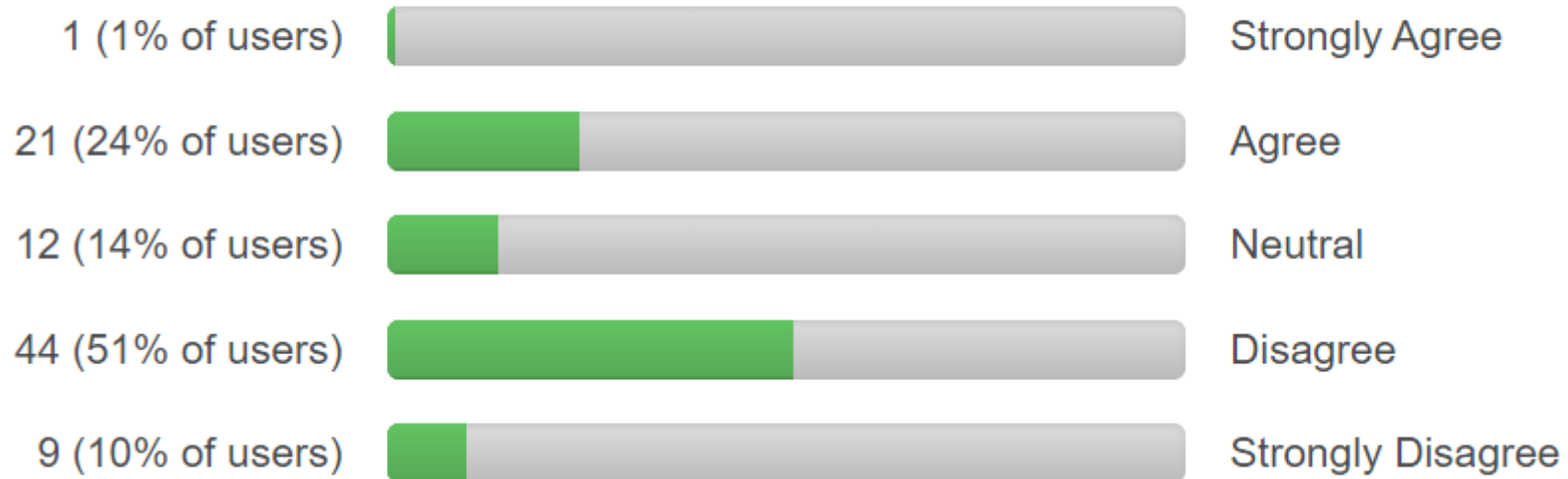

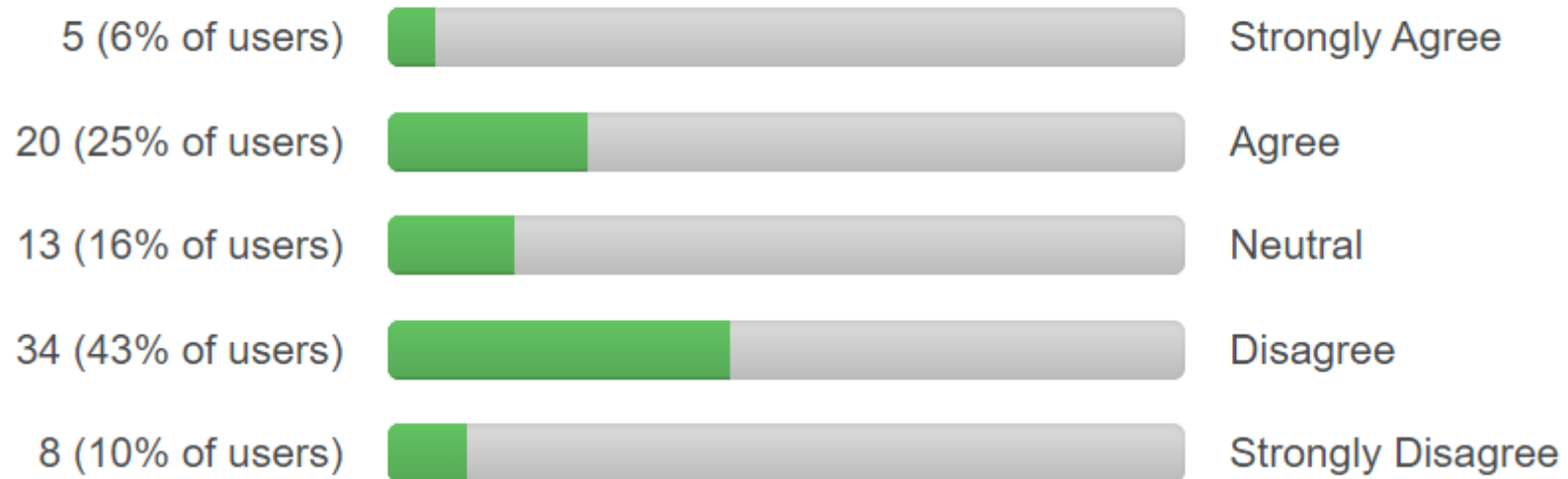


Information Privacy
